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### Training on SOUL 3.0 by BMU



## Refresher Course by BMCP



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

He actively participated in various events, earning certificates and medals, and received encouragement and felicitation from our college's director and trustees.



## Seminar on International Studies by BMCLAH



### **Expert lecture by BMCA**



## **Expert Lecture by BMCA**


