



MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

Between

And

This Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) is entered into on this 14th day of May, 2025, by and between:

Responsibilities of BMCP

BMCP agrees to:

1. Provide students and faculty access to BRAHM facilities for research, training, and internships.
2. Offer unrestricted access to BMCP library and relevant research resources.
3. Share institutional expertise to assist BRAHM in capacity building.
4. Organize at least one annual seminars/workshops with BRAHM participation.
5. Design credit-based industry internships within curriculum.
6. Submit an annual report on collaborative activities and outcomes.

BRAHM agrees to:

1. Participate in co-developing curriculum and skills training modules.
2. Provide paid internships and hands-on training to BMCP students annually.
3. Deliver a minimum of one expert sessions per academic year.
4. Facilitate at least one industrial visit per year, subject to mutual convenience
5. Offer mentorship for final-year student projects (chargeable if conducted at BRAHM).
6. Consider BMCP students for recruitment, subject to vacancies and skills fit.
7. Provide technical support to BMCP in organizing academic and training events.

A Joint Coordination Committee (JCC) comprising two members from each party shall be formed to:

- Plan activities and define KPIs.
- Monitor progress regularly.
- Resolve conflicts or issues.
- Review this MoU annually.

Any intellectual property (IP) generated from joint research shall be jointly owned, unless otherwise agreed upon. Both parties shall maintain confidentiality of proprietary data and information shared during the course of this MoU.
