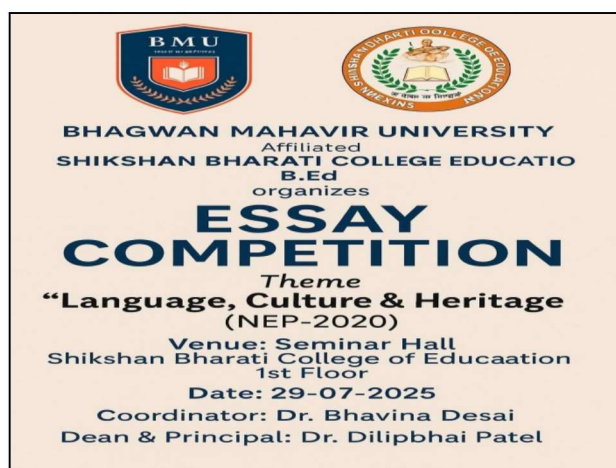


Celebrating 5 Years of NEP-2020

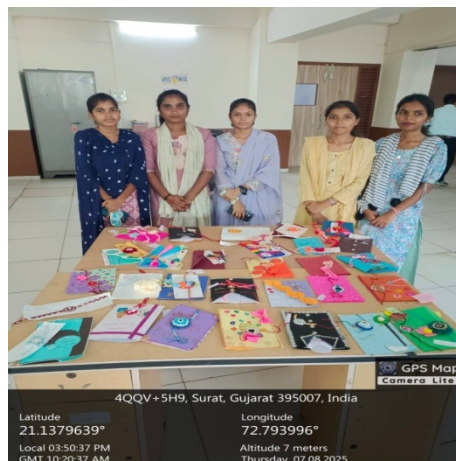

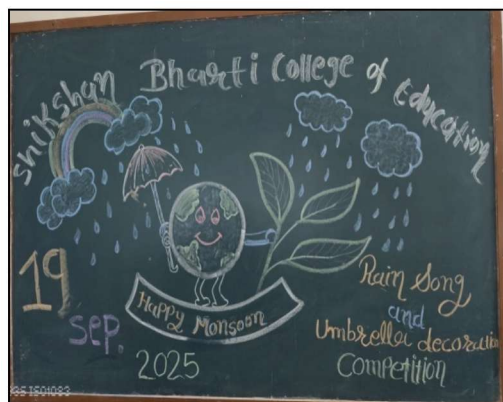

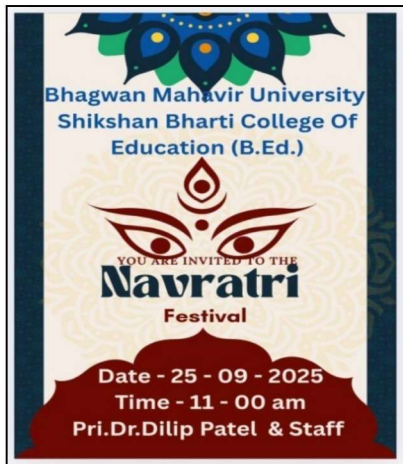
