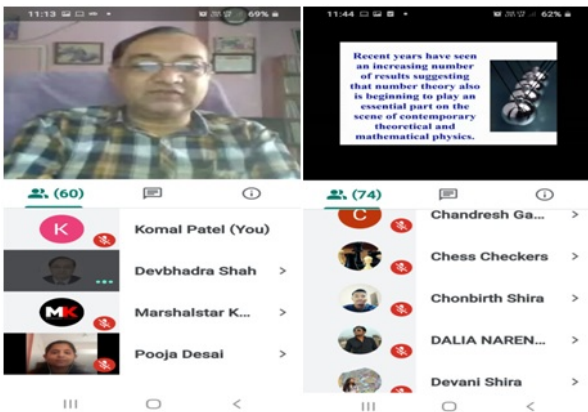


Students of Bhagwan Mahavir University developed nearly 1000 ecobricks. These ecobricks are plastic bottles packed with used plastic to set density. They serve as a reusable building blocks. Ecobricks were produced by the students of Bhagwan Mahavir University primarily as a means of managing used plastic by sequestering it and containing it safely, by terminally reducing the net surface

area of the packed plastic to effectively secure the plastic from degrading into toxins and microplastics. These ecobrick process promotes the collaborative process as a means to encourage students to take collective responsibility for their consumed plastic and to use it to produce a useful product.

- Criterion-7: Institutional Values and Best Practices.



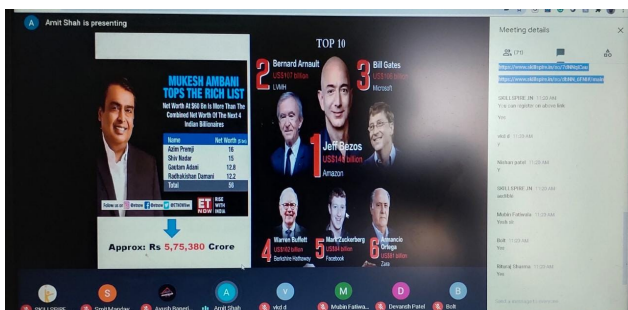
Celebration of National Constitution Day by BMU

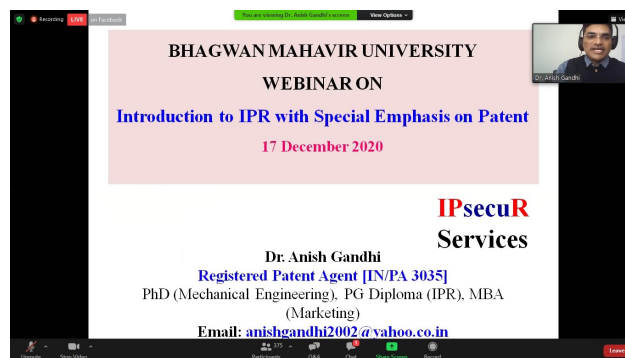

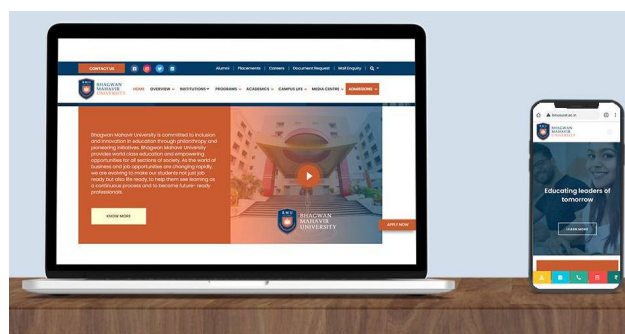

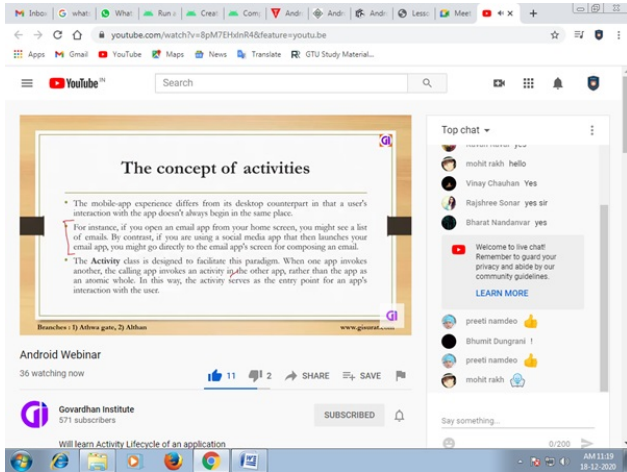
Webinar on “Activity life cycle”

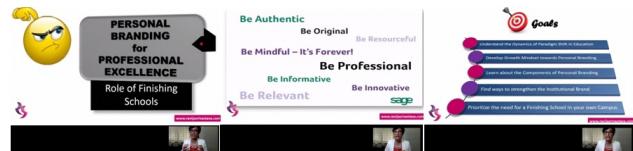

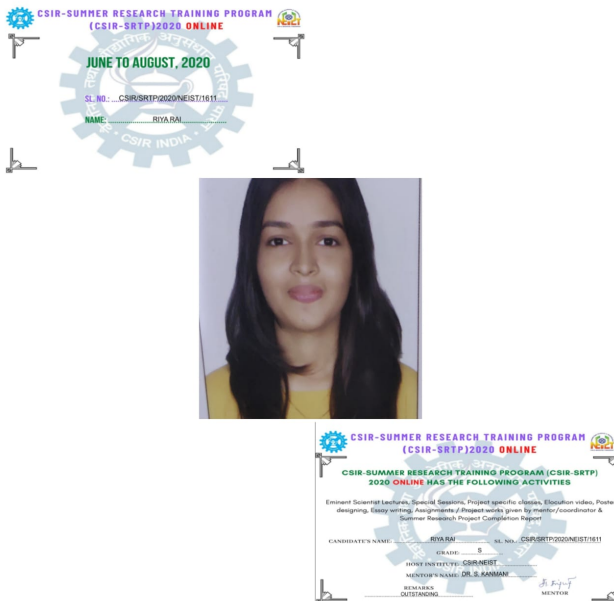

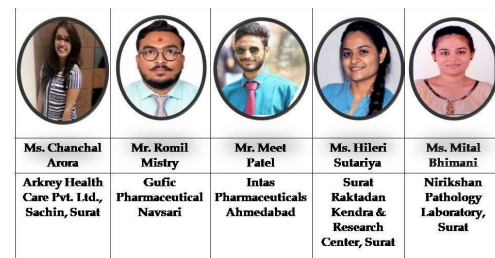
