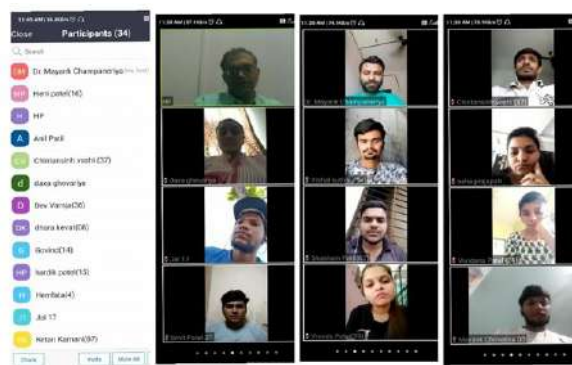
Feedback of Online Lectures conducted by Bhagwan Mahavir University during the lockdown

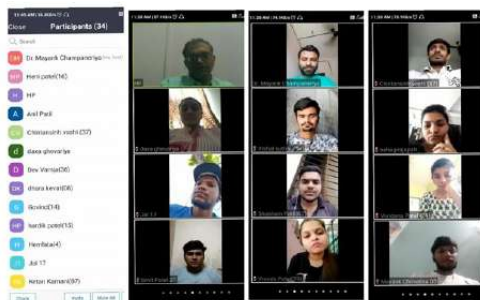

Webinar on “Resume Preparation” in Bhagwan Mahavir College of Basic & Applied Science

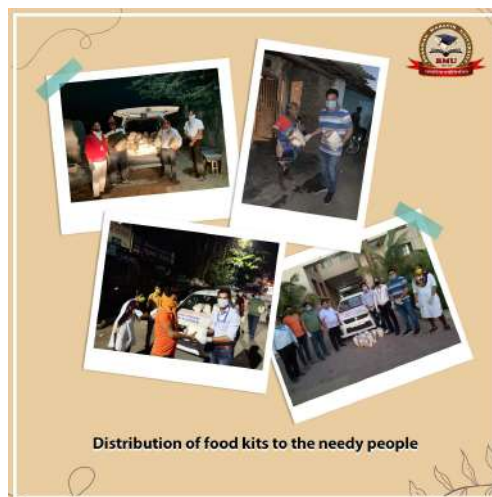

Distribution of foods kits to the needy people during lockdown

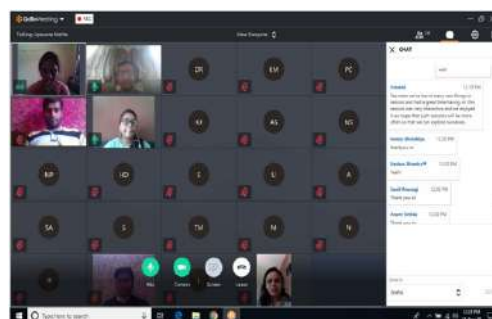

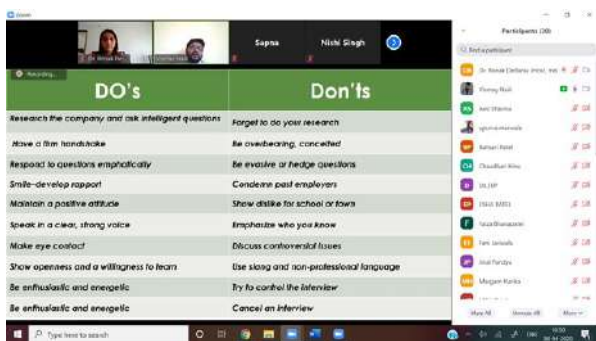

Webinar on “Export is Easy” in Bhagwan Mahavir College of Commerce & Management Studies

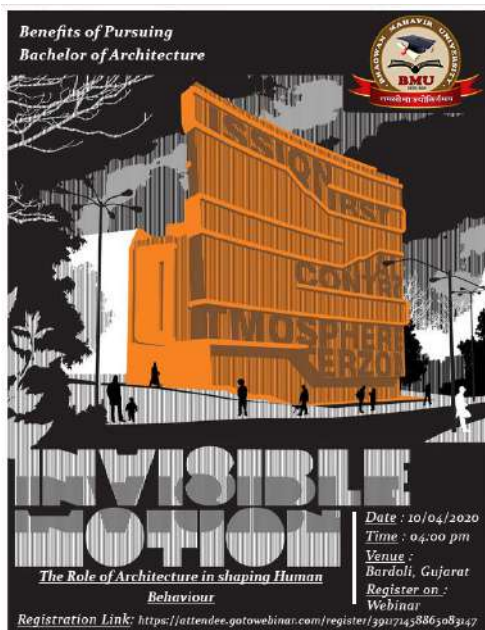

A good research proposals should communicate the researcher’s knowledge of the field and his method to convey the emergent nature of the qualitative design. The proposal should follow a discernible logic from the introduction to presentation of the appendices. During the session he covered various topics such as components of a research proposal, title, introduction, literature review, methodology, plan - schedule and schedule of activities, budget, details of the research team and references. The title of a research proposal should be concise and descriptive. The quality of the writing the proposal is important. Check the following common mistakes: (a) Are the sentences too long? (b) Are the paragraphs too long? (c) Avoid Plagiarism: have author cited his sources each time he express an idea that is not his own? The session was full of informative and practical learning which kept the research scholar engaged throughout session.

Webinar on “Likely Post Pandemic Architecture” in Bhagwan Mahavir College of Architecture

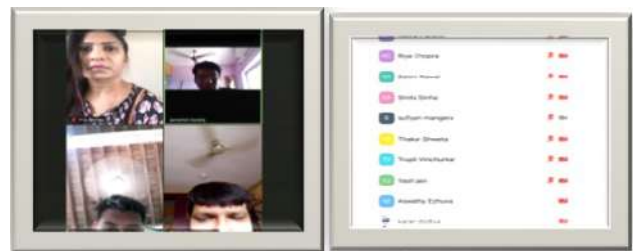

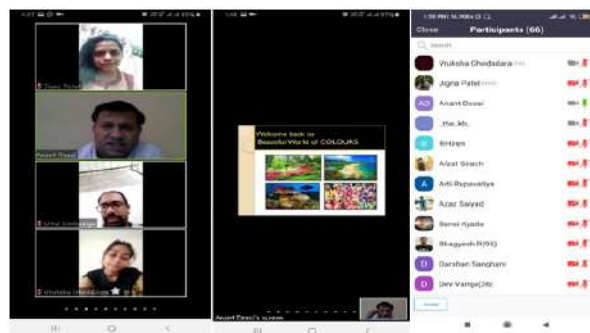
This lockdown period has surely found strengths and creativity of students in a different way! And students of Bhagwan Mahavir University set a great example of

Webinar on "Synthetic Dyes and Its application" in Bhagwan Arihant Institute of Technology

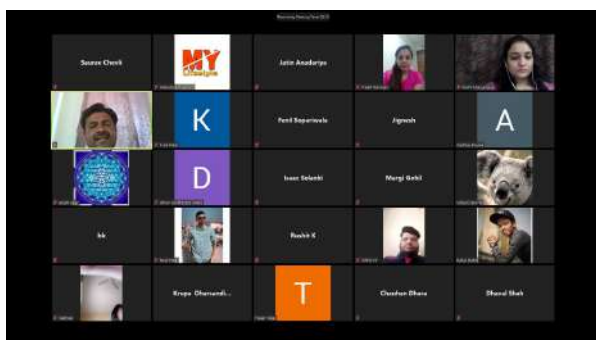

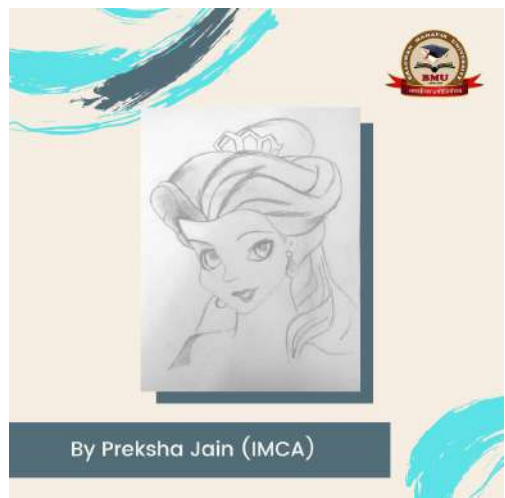

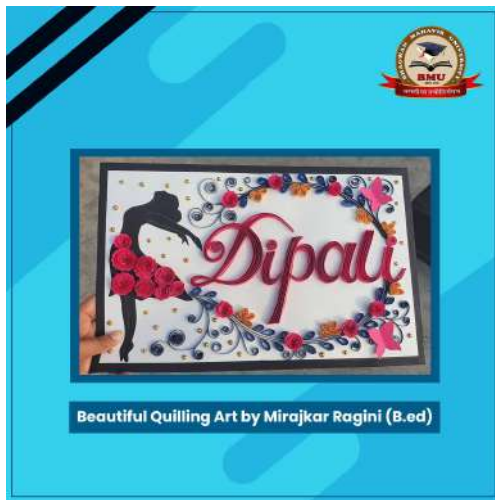
