




# 13. RULES & REGULATIONS: BMCN & BMCM

## GENERAL CODE OF CONDUCT

### 13.1 DRESS CODE

Wearing of formal dress is compulsory at the time of Theory classes and uniform is compulsory for clinical posting and field posting. For the boys the formal dress is shirt and trousers or formal suit with proper footwear. For girls the formal dress is Punjabi dress and with proper footwear. The students are expected to follow an appropriate and decent dress code with proper footwear at the time of Theory classes.

### 13.2 IDENTIFICATION CARD

All students will be issued Photo Identification (ID) Card to certify the enrolment in the Bhagwan Mahavir college of Nursing as well as Bhagwan Mahavir school of Nursing. This ID card is compulsory for each and every student to carry in college hours and clinical hours too. In case of losses of the ID card, a new card will be issued on payment of Rs. 100/-.

### 13.3 SYLLABUS

The Syllabus of the particular subjects will be provided to all students. According to that students have to secure 80% attendance in theory and 100% attendance for the clinical and field experience.

### 13.4 CLASS CONDUCT

- The students are expected to be in the classroom at least five minutes prior to the commencement of the class, Unpunctuality is not acceptable.
- We have a “Bell-System and students should obey the Bell system. The 1st Bell is at 9:00am in the morning for First Lecture. For the clinical, college timing will be 08:00 am to 04:00pm.
- Every students Should purchase their respective Semester books within 3 days and it should be carry in the classroom each and everyday
- If the students not maintain their subject book in the classroom as well coming without homework then respective subject faculty will take a proper action against the students.
- Use of mobile phones is strictly prohibited in the class rooms, corridors and inside the blocks. Violation would imply confiscation of the mobile phones. Students are expected to behave in a responsible manner and abstain from chatting Amongst themselves while the class is in progress.
- Activities like video shooting, photography, playing musical instruments and listening to Radio and tape recorders are prohibited in the campus.

- Any indiscipline or misbehaviours in class would warrant disciplinary action against the Student.
- If the students are not following the above rules then the penalty will be laid on them Which include the following:
- Students will be prohibited from appearing in the course or in the internal and external Examination if they are not maintaining their attendance criteria.
- Students will be restricted to seat in class room if misbehaviour or any kind of disturbance Is found and that period attendance will not be included.
- Parents will be invited for the discussion
- Given special assignment
- Any other punishment which the principal of the college feels appropriate.

### **13.5 DISCIPLINARY RULES**

- Every student must carry his/her Identity Card
- Theory Attendance (80% Minimum) , clinical : 100% attendance
- Behave in a responsible manner
- Respect to the faculty/staff of the college
- Disciplinary action [Against Indiscipline or misbehaviour]
- No student shall indulge in any activity that might be illegal or may lead to disorderliness;
- No student shall be in possession of liquor , drugs or any intoxicating materials, Nor would consume such things; Smoking Cigarettes/chewing pan or tobacco or gutkha is Strictly prohibited.
- Use of mobiles phones is strictly prohibited. Activities like video shooting, Photography, playing musical Instruments and listening to Radio, Tape Recorder, etc. are prohibited in the Campus.
- Use of helmets is compulsory for everyone who rides a two-wheeler to and from the Campus;
- Any kind of ragging in the class, Campus or in the bus or even outside the campus is strictly prohibited.
- Students are not allowed to shout in the corridors, class rooms as well as on the stairs.
- Students are not allowed to sit on the stairs during, after, and before the lecture hours.

### **13.6 LIBRARY RULES & REGULATIONS**

- Mobile use is strictly prohibited in Library.
- The students should enter their names in the register on arrival and departure.

- The students shall enter in the library only after submitting their bag on the Property Counter.
- Students should take care of cleanliness of the library.
- The student can issue the 03 (Three) books at a time for the period of 14 days.

Fundamental lab is well equipped with adequate and modern instruments. 4 mannequins and 1 mobile CPR model on which students are allowed to practice their procedures before encountering the patients.

Child health nursing has all the modern amenities with 2 pediatric mannequins and all the necessary articles needed for the students to perform their child health care procedures.





➤ **MATERNITY HEALTH NURSING LAB**

The lab is equipped with 2 mannequins, models of pelvis, fetal skull, placenta and spongy foetus to practice different mechanisms of labour. It is also equipped with variety of instruments and labour kit.



➤ **COMMUNITY HEALTH NURSING LAB**

Community lab is equipped with adequate community bags, instruments, AV aids and family folders and can accommodate 20-25 students to practice the procedures at a time.



➤ **NUTRITION LAB**

Crockery, cutlery, adequate fuel and stove tables, fruits and other groceries are made available for the cookery practice. Cereals, pulses, available as and when required



➤ **PRE-CLINICAL SCIENCE LAB**

A separate lab for anatomy & physiology is available in the college premises with Models, Chart, skeletons and different specimens.
