
POLICY STATEMENT

- HONORARY MEMBERS: Hon'ble Vice Chancellor, Deans of the Faculty,
 Directors, Training and placement Officer, the nominated faculty members and the
 persons of repute from inside as well as outside the University will be the honorary
 members, who is likely to promote the interest of the association



***** MEMBERSHIP ELIGIBILITY

- The cell will be open to all the students who have obtained degree/diploma/certificate from Bhagwan Mahavir University, Surat-Gujarat. The membership shall be divided into an Executive Committee, and General Body dealing with appropriate issues pertaining to alumni and associate interest of the University.
- Membership fees will one time Rs. 1000/- (subject to revision) to be paid at the time of

- ALL GENERAL BODY MEETINGS must be held to decide the future course of action of the association at least once in a year.

- The purpose of alumni volunteer networks organized regionally or by special interests is to support and further the mission of the Alumni and Constituent Engagement team and the university. When alumni volunteer networks are officially recognized, they benefit by having access to the Alumni and Constituent Engagement team's expertise and support in communications, marketing, events management, resources, and fundraising efforts.
- In order for an alumni organization to have the designation of an official university network, the approval of the Alumni and Constituent Engagement team is necessary.
