She showed her projects where there are many challenges like the architecture plan is done but you have to change just interior layout of Interior spaces like living room, master bedroom, and children bedroom.




She designed extended niche & create extended seating area, entrance portion of the bedroom and study area, dressing with round mirror and storage.

the block and then carve with tools with proper precautions as it can harm anyone. After completing carving they used Acrylic colours as they are not soaked by pop block and they use different color scheme according to their design and give it final touch with brushstrokes


