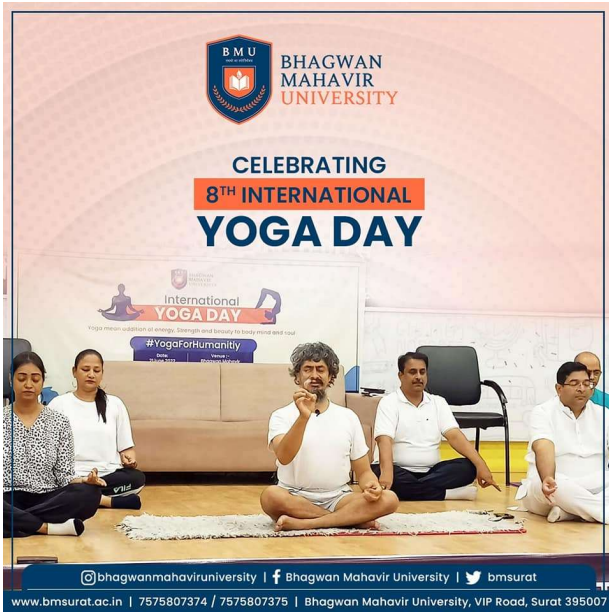

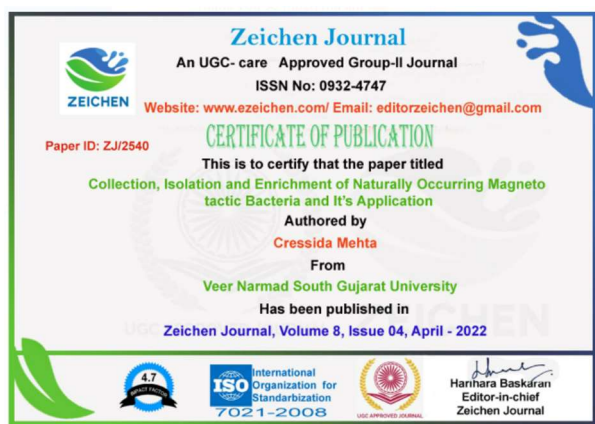
Faculty achievements at BMCBAS

One Day Industrial Visit at “Hyundai AutoZone” by BM Polytechnic

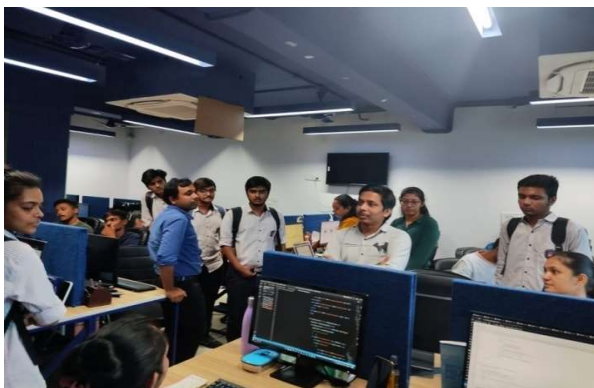

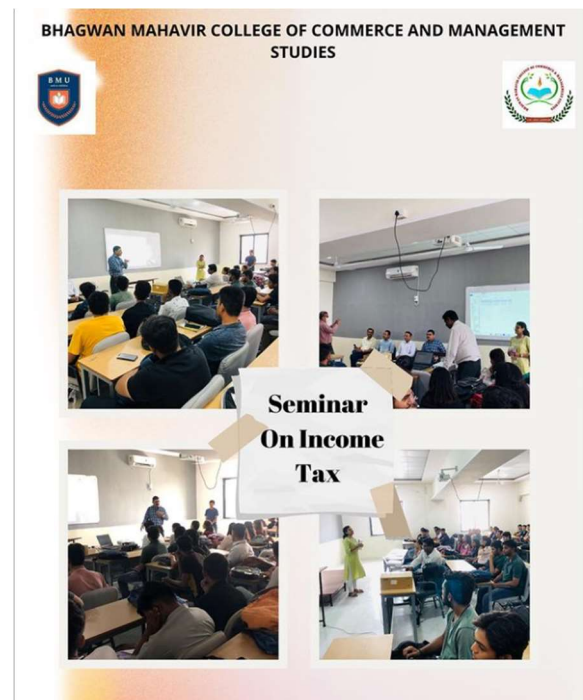


Guest Lecture by BMCCMS
