school and aware the students of schools about harm of drugs and also take the pledge of "Say no to Drug" from citizens. Around 500 people had taken pledge during the event.




#### One week for nation by Environment Cell-BMU

# Webinar on "An Overview of IPR and Patents for Students" by BMCBAS




# Webinar on "Career Options after Diploma" by BM Polytechnic


